

# 10 Minute Prayer Plan

1. PRAISE: How can I praise God my Father?

*Psalm 100:4, "Enter his gates with thanksgiving; go into his courts with praise. Give thanks to him and praise his name." NLT*

2. REPENT: Is the Spirit convicting me of sin?

*Psalm 51:3-4, "For I recognize my rebellion; it haunts me day and night. Against you, and you alone, have I sinned; I have done what is evil in your sight. You will be proved right in what you say, and your judgment against me is just." NLT*

3. ASK: What "Big Thing" am I asking for?

*Matthew 7:7-8, "Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you. <sup>8</sup> For everyone who asks, receives. Everyone who seeks, finds. And to everyone who knocks, the door will be opened." NLT*

4. YIELD: Am I regularly obeying the Spirit?

*John 14:15, "you love me, obey my commandments." NLT*

5. EXAMPLE: Father, make me an example others can follow. How can I be a better example?

*1 Corinthians 11:1, "And you should imitate me, just as I imitate Christ." NLT*

6. RELATIONSHIPS: How can I love others in my relationships? My marriage, children, friends, neighbors, etc.

*John 13:34-35, "So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. <sup>35</sup> Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples." NLT*

7. THREE: Who are three people the Spirit is asking me to pray for and invite to Rogers First Assembly?

*Colossians 4:5, "Live wisely among those who are not believers, and make the most of every opportunity." NLT*

8. EYES AND EARS: Pray that each person has a soft heart so their eyes and ears are open to the gospel.

*Matthew 13:14-15, "This fulfills the prophecy of Isaiah that says, 'When you hear what I say, you will not understand. When you see what I do, you will not comprehend.'<sup>15</sup> For the hearts of these people are hardened, and their ears cannot hear, and they have closed their eyes—so their eyes cannot see, and their ears cannot hear, and their hearts cannot understand, and they cannot turn to me and let me heal them." NLT*

9. ATTITUDE: How does my attitude need to change to be more like Jesus' attitude?

*Philippians 2:5, "You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had." NLT*

10. MISSION: How is God asking me to move our church mission forward by praying, serving and loving others?

*Matthew 16:18, "Now I say to you that you are Peter (which means 'rock'), and upon this rock I will build my church, and all the powers of hell will not conquer it." NLT*
